Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction for quashing of notices dated 12.04.2023 and 20.04.2023 issued to petitioners No.1 and 2, respectively.

As per status report filed by way of affidavit of Kapil Ahlawat, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Old Gurugram dated 12.05.2023, after enquiry, no cognizable offence was found to be made out and the matter was found to be of civil nature and the complaint filed by the complainant was recommended to be filed. Para No.11 of the status report reads as under:-

“11. That after taking into consideration the above facts coming forth during the enquiry, no cognizable offence has been found to be made and the matter has been found to be of civil nature and the complaint filed by the complainant was recommended to be filed. The Incharge EOW-1, Gurugram also agreed with the said

findings of ASI Anil and he also recommended to file the complaint. The deponent also endorsed the findings of ASI Anil and Incharge EOW-1, Gurugram and sent the same to the senior officers for consideration.”

In view of the contentions made in the abovesaid status report, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
