ASHOK KUMAR VERMA, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.110 dated 06.03.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341, 506 and 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (to which Section 326 of the IPC was added later on) at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

2. Vide order dated 16.11.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, it was ordered that no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has now been amicably settled between the parties. Nothing is to be

recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required in the case. Therefore, the present petition may be allowed.

5. Learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant admits the factum of compromise and submits that respondent No.2/complainant has no objection if the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the record.

5. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and order dated 16.11.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

6. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
