The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.470 dated 24.10.2017, under Sections 279 and 304-A IPC, registered at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal on the basis of Compromise Deed dated 16.05.2022 (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Randeep, submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner herein stands acquitted of the charges levelled against him in FIR No.470 dated 24.10.2017, vide judgment dated 01.11.2022, passed by the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal, which fact is also conceded by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner. Copy of

judgment dated 01.11.2022 has been supplied by learned State counsel in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.
