1. Prayer in the application is for placing on record the order dated 19.04.2023 as Annexure P-4 and exemption from filing certified copy of Annexure P-4.

2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Copy of order dated 19.04.2023 is taken on record as Annexure P-4 and filing certified copy of Annexure P-4 is exempted.

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1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 20.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 20.04.2023 (Annexure P-3).

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3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amish Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.
7. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.
8. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
