The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.157 dated 19.07.2022, registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 224, 341, 379-B, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.04.2023 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Devinder Pal, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
