In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is to grant them the wages for working on a public holiday. In the petition, no details of the public holiday on which the petitioners had discharged their duties, have been mentioned.

Even otherwise, in the reply the respondents have mentioned that for working on a gazetted holiday, compensatory leave is to be granted and as the petitioners have not given any detail of the public holiday on which the petitioners have discharged the duties, nothing could be mentioned as to whether the petitioners were given any compensatory leave in case the same was asked for.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the above noted facts, the present petition be disposed of with the

direction to the respondents that in case the petitioners file a detailed representation giving the details of public holiday on which they had discharged their duties, let the same be considered in accordance with law and in case, any compensatory leave has been given to the petitioners, the same will be brought to the notice of the petitioners and in case, the petitioners have not been given compensatory leave for working on a holiday, they will be paid accordingly for working on a public holiday.

Ordered accordingly.
