On 28.04.2023, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.21 dated 20.1.2022 registered under Sections 279, 336, 427 IPC and Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

Counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and has nothing to do with the recovered liquor and Skoda car No.PB58-D-0002 which were stated to be seized by the police from the place of occurrence. He further submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and that the petitioner though involved in 4 other criminal cases is already enlarged on bail in the said cases. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation with the police.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from SI Hari Krishan submits that the petitioner is required by the police for proper investigation of the case. However, the State counsel has not disputed the fact that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and recovery of liquor and the aforesaid

Skoda car is already effected.

Now be listed on 17.8.2023.

In view of above, the petitioner is hereby directed to join the investigation with the police and in case of arrest, he is to be released on interim bail by the investigating officer/arresting officer to his own satisfaction till the next date fixed in this case. The petitioner is also to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C. ”

Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Amit Bhatia, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narwana, District Jind, has been filed on behalf of respondent-State.

On instructions from H.C. Anil Kumar, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 28.04.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 28.04.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
