The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of direction to the respondents to adhere his request for not depositing the bid amount of 75% which could not be made within the time stipulated because of certain financial constraints and non releasing of certain amounts.

The petitioner has approached the respondents by way of representation dated 21.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) which is based upon the policy of Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran dated 23.02.2021 (Annexure P-5) wherein such extension can be granted alongwith certain penal interest which the petitioner is ready to deposit. Therefore, it is contended that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner as submitted and referred to above within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pravindra S. Chauhan, Sr. Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent (s)-State.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 21.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) keeping in mind

the policy dated 23.02.2021 (Annexure P-5) within four weeks. The decision so taken, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
