The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking quashing of order dated 02.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist class, Kapurthala, whereby, the application moved by him under Section 311 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, during trial of case FIR No.24 dated 12.04.2015, registered under Sections 304-A, 279, 337, 338 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Subhanpur, Kapurthala, for re-summoning witnesses Gurjant Singh son of Sarwan Singh, Major Singh son of Karnail Singh, Bhupinder Singh son of Manjit Singh, for further cross-examination, was dismissed.

The petitioner has also challenged the order dated 08.08.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, whereby, the revision petition filed by the petitioner against order dated 02.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) was also dismissed.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the instant petition has

been rendered infructuous as the petitioner herein stands acquitted in case FIR No.24 dated 12.04.2015, registered under Sections 304-A, 279, 337, 338 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Subhanpur vide judgment dated 27.01.2023, a copy whereof has been handed over in Court and is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

The aforesaid factum of passing of judgment dated 27.01.2023 by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kapurthala, acquitting the petitioner herein, is admitted by learned counsel for the petitioner and he, therefore, concedes that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above-said submission(s) made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Pending application/s, if any, shall stands disposed of.
