Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.76 dated 8.4.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Chheharata, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of previous order, the petitioner has already made payment of ₹ 6 lakh to the complainant by way of bank demand draft. He further submits that the petitioner has also joined the investigation with the police.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner. He further made prayer that in case direction is given to the parties to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Amritsar, dispute regarding balance amount and sale transaction in question could also be settled easily.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Tejbir Singh apprised

the Court that in compliance of previous order, the petitioner has made payment of ₹ 6 lakh and further, joined the investigation and further submits that now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 20.5.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is made clear that in future if both the parties move any application before learned District & Sessions Judge, Amritsar for purpose of mediation, the same is to be referred by the said Court to the concerned mediator of Mediation & Conciliation Centre situated in District Courts Complex, Amritsar for that purpose.
