Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.3 and 4 to pay an amount of Rs.50 crores as compensation to the petitioner on account of causing mental and physical agony, trauma, hardships, harassment to the petitioner and his family members by filing multiple false police complaints as well as private complaints before the Court of Sessions, Gurugram using minor children as an instrument and for filing multiple false cases in various Courts of Gurugram despite the fact that all the said complaints were found to be false upon investigation/inquiry by the police.

Apparently, it is a private dispute between the petitioner as well as the respondents 3 and 4 in which the Agencies and Instrumentalities of the State are not involved. The dispute being in the domain of a private lis between the parties and casting no obligation on the State for breach of any such obligation by the State and/or its instrumentalities, the writ jurisdiction for awarding such compensation would not be maintainable.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.

The petitioner would, however, be at liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law, if so advised.
