This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 5 as the petitioners have got married against the wishes of private respondents and for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and the family members of petitioner No.2.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala (respondent No.2) to consider and decide the representation dated 25.04.2023 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by petitioner No.1 seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
