1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 31.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2.

2. On 28.04.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned State Counsel prays for an adjournment to verify as to whether the appeal (Annexure P-6) has been received by the authorities or not.

To be heard along with CWP-8784-2023”

3. Learned State Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent No.1 has submitted that he has got instructions from Manveer Singh, Senior

Assistant, Department of Local Government of Punjab, that the appeal (Annexure P-6) has been received by the respondent authorities and the said appeal would be decided within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the abovesaid statement made by learned State Counsel satisfies the claim of the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with directions to the Appellate Authority-respondent No.1 to decide the appeal (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
