The instant writ petition had been filed against the action taken by the respondents in an illegal manner despite the issuance of letter of acceptance to the petitioner being the highest bidder.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner is no more in talk with the counsel and further instructions are awaited.

The matter had been earlier adjourned on six consecutive dates either on account of absence of counsel for the petitioner or on the request to enable the counsel for the petitioner to complete instructions.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
