1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of Constitution with a prayer to direct respondent Nos. 1 to 4 not to harass, humiliate and torture them and their family members, under the garb of police inquiry, pursuant to the complaint dated 17.02.2023 Annexure P-7 filed by respondent Nos. 6 and 7.

2. After issuance of notice, status report was filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Ajib Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sirsa on behalf of the respondent Nos. 1 to 4.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the complaint dated 16.02.2023 (Annexure P-7) was filed by respondent No. 6 and 7 against the

petitioner No.2. After the receipt of the complaint, the inquiry was

conducted by SI Banwari Lal, being Inquiry Officer Sirsa and as per the said inquiry, no cognizable offence is made out in the present case. Learned State counsel further submits that the official respondents have not harassed or humiliated anyone including the petitioners or their family members/relatives . He submits that since the inquiry into the complaint Annexure P-7 has already been concluded and recommended to be filed, the petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, this Court is of the view that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.

6. Needless to observe that the petitioners as well as respondent Nos. 6 and 7 shall be at liberty to avail their remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
