1. The petitioner is seeking to quash the order dated 02.03.2021 vide which he was declared as proclaimed offender in the case bearing FIR No. 112 dated 04.07.2016 under Sections 201/302 (later on added Sections 363/366-A/364/376/376-D IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act) registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the arrest of the petitioner was effected and trial of the case has culminated in acquittal of the petitioner and the present petition has become infructuous.
