This is an application for placing on record the copy of FIR No.338, dated 24.11.2022 and letter dated 21.12.2022 declaring names of the District Presidents of Bhartiya Janta Party as Annexures A-1 and A-2.

MAIN CASE

The prayer in the present petition is for quashing the order passed by respondent No.4 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala received by the petitioner on 31.05.2021.

Status report by way of affidavit of Lalit Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Batala has been filed, wherein it was averred that the complaints/representations submitted by the petitioner had been duly considered and that the order was passed on the assessment of said reports.

Thereafter, a further assessment was conducted by the Addl. Director General of Police, Security, Punjab on the basis of latest inputs received from the concerned quarter and no specific input indicating any threat to the security of the petitioner was received. Hence, it was recommended that the security cover to the petitioner at the State expenses was not warranted. Even though the aforesaid status report was filed by the respondents on 18.08.2021, however, no response controverting the same has been filed till date.

Learned Sr. Counsel for the petitioner contends that he has been instructed to state that the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed at this stage and as such the present petition has become infructuous at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage.
