Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State has no objection to the same.

Accordingly, the application is allowed and the main case is pre-poned from 07.02.2024 and the same is taken up on Board today itself.

The prayer made in the present writ petition is for seeking issuance of directions to respondents to de-register the petitioner's institution from the purview of Section 41 of the Juvenile Justice (Care

and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and to declare that the said provisions are not applicable to the petitioners.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the instant petition had been filed because the petitioners were under wrong impression and got themselves registered under Section 41 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Registration Certificate was also issued to the petitioners on 08.10.2018. The petitioners had sought the de-registration but as no action has been taken, hence, the instant petition was filed.

It is averred that the above said registration was valid only for a period of 05 years from 26.10.2018 to 25.10.2023 and that as the said period has already come to an end, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the respondent-State has no objection to the same.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
