This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuing directions to respondents no.1 to 3 for conducting the demarcation through revenue official through process of government computerized machinery or satellite system etc. regarding Panchayat land / Common Purpose land as mentioned in the resolution dated 14.07.2018.

Learned counsel appearing for private respondents has submitted that the land in question has fallen within the municipal area and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not touch with his client and submits that the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner or its successors in interest to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
