1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for the issuance of any writ, order or mandate especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to sanction/enter the mutation of the land in favour of petitioner as per transfer deed (Annexure P-1) given by the father of the petitioner to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a civil suit as per Section 45 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887.

3. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
