1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P-13) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Chandigarh whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.07 dated 10.01.2022 under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station South Sector 34, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till her appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that her bail application, which she would be filing on her surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel

for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to her. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
