AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.5,10,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Ten Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, Rs.4,10,000/- will be paid to the appellant No.2 and Rs.1,00,000/- will be paid to appellant No.3.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques, one for Rs.4,10,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Ten Thousand Only) favouring appellant No. 2-Jatin s/o Charanjit Kumar and one for Rs.1,00,000/-(Rupees One Lakh Only) favouring appellant No. 3-Kamlesh Rani with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 24.03.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

It is stated that the Insurance Company will have the recovery rights qua

the amount enhanced in the same manner as was granted by MACT, Sangrur.

Appeal stands disposed of.
