1. Present petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to implement the order dated 10.02.2005 (Annexure P-3) by which, the case of the petitioner was approved for the grant of compassionate appointment.

2. Further prayer of the petitioner is that in the alternative, legal notice submitted by the petitioner dated 13.02.2023, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-5 be decided by the respondents in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from Mr. Mukesh Kumar, Superintendent and Mr. Karamdeep, Assistant, O/o Director Elementary Education, Panchkula, submits that legal notice dated 13.02.2023 (Annexure P-5) will be decided within a period of four weeks from today by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case the petitioner is found entitled for relief as per the speaking order, the same will be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further but with liberty that in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the speaking order, he can avail appropriate remedy.
