1. Aggrieved by the cancellation of the petitioner's candidature for appointment as a maths teacher, he has filed the present writ petition. The candidature of the petitioner has been cancelled on account of his involvement in a criminal case arising from FIR No.177 dated 26.10.2020, registered under Section 323, 325, 341, 148, 149 of IPC, in which the police after completing the investigation had presented the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the Court has not framed any charges and the petitioner deserves to be appointed.

3. This Court has considered the submissions. In the present case, the State is recruiting teachers to impart education to the students who are of an impressionable age.

4. In such circumstances, this Court does not find it appropriate to issue any direction in favour of a person whose criminal antecedents are not clear.

- 5. Hence, no ground to issue the writ as prayed for, is made out.
- 6. Dismissed.
- 7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
