VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)

1. The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No.2 dated 15.02.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A, 420 IPC registered at Police Station NRI Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that petition qua petitioner no.1 stands dismissed in terms of the order dated 12.02.2018 and she has been declared as proclaimed offender.
3. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2/complainant submits that petitioners No.2 and 3 have been acquitted by the learned trial Court in terms of the judgment dated 21.07.2023 and the present petition has become infructuous.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that he believes the statement of the learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant and the present petition may be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
