Learned counsel for the petitioner has moved instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to take legal action on his representation dated 18.04.2023 (Annexure P-3), wherein, it has been alleged that private respondents No.4 to 7 have caused huge financial loss to the tune of Rs.7 lakh per day and also committed forgery against the petitioner while selling goods/material without the consent of the petitioner is actually owned by him.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Copy supplied.

However, without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the Court deems it suffice to issue a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to examine the representation dated 18.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) and to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.

Copy of the orders passed after considering the representation shall be supplied to the petitioner in advance.

In light of the above, the instant petition is disposed of.
