The present revision petition arises out of judgment dated 07.01.2008 passed by the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur, whereby, the petitioner was convicted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, later affirmed vide judgment dated 15.12.2008 passed by the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, thereby upholding the sentence awarded by the trial court, which records as follows:-

“Considering the above said circumstances that gravity of the offence is quite serious, therefore, I sentence the convict to undergo RI for a period of nine months and further ordered to pay fine of Rs.10,000/- and in default of payment of above said fine, accused will have further undergo further RI for two months. It is further ordered that on recovery of above said fine, Rs.5000/- will be paid to the complainant towards expenses incurred by him in prosecuting the case but the above said payment will be made only after the expiry period

*appeal or revision and if any, or result of the same. File be
consigned to the record room.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner informs this Court that the petitioner has unfortunately expired and the amount of fine as ordered by the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur already stands deposited at the time of post conviction and prior to the filing of first appeal.

In view of the aforesaid, the petitioner having unfortunately expired and the amount of fine having deposited, the present petition stands abated.
