The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.93 dated 24.03.2023 registered under Sections 285, 336, 506 IPC and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Chahapar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.04.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rahul Tiyaagi admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
