The present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner at the instance of private respondent and not to conduct multiple enquiries in the same matter which has already been enquired many times.

This court vide order dated 24.5.2022 had issued notice of motion in this case and learned State counsel was directed to file a status report. The same was filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that multiple inquiries were conducted in the matter and despite that petitioner is being harassed by the respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jagjit Singh submits that FIR has already been registered in this case against the petitioner and the same is pending investigation. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR was registered after filing of the present petition.

Having heard counsel for the parties and after perusing the record, it is apparent that FIR No.44 dated 21.6.2022 under sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC has been registered at P.S. Hathur against the petitioner and the same is pending investigation.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating agency to conduct a free and fair investigation in the aforementioned FIR in accordance with law.
