Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., against the impugned order dated 06.09.2016 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Moga (Annexure P-1) by virtue of which the summoning order under Section 319 Cr.P.C., of the respondents vide order dated 21.12.2015 passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Moga has been set aside.
