By way of present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.1210, dated 02.10.2022, under Sections 21 and 27-A of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was implicated in the aforementioned FIR based on disclosure made by the co-accused(s) involving recovery of small quantity of contraband.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that there are two other cases of NDPS pending against the petitioner, though, in both the cases, he has already been granted the benefit of regular bail.

Having argued for some time, learned counsel for petitioner

submits that he does not want to press the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial court within a period of 07 days from today.

In view of the aforesaid, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial court within a period of 07 days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be disposed of in accordance with law, within a period of two days thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
