[1] Counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition in which the direction was sought under Section 482 Cr.P.C. against the official respondents to inquire the matter relating to FIR No. 179, dated 02.03.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Karnal, under Sections 304-B read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short '*the IPC*') and Section 34 thereof and FIR No. 193, dated 04.03.2016, registered at the same Police Station under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452 and 506 of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959.
