The prayer in this petition is for quashing of the order dated 12.03.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kharar in complaint case No.NACT/120/2017, CNI No.PBSAA10004452017 dated 16.05.2017 registered under Section 138 of the NI Act, whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioner and respondent no.2.
