1. This is the 1st petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in:-

2. Upon instructions from ASI Harjit Singh, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He submits that as the *challan* has been prepared and is likely to be presented soon, there is no need to file the report of the Investigating Officer as directed by this Court in its order dated 01.05.2023.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, present petition is allowed and order dated 01.05.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the satisfaction of the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
