Petitioners are seeking to quash FIR No. 109 dated 20.07.2014 under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC & offence under Section 308 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Dasuya on the basis of compromise.

In terms of the order dated December 06, 2017, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court on 25.01.2018 to get the statements recorded.

The report was received to the effect that the parties had not appeared in the Court to get the statements recorded and as such, no appropriate report regarding the genuineness of the compromise, if any, between the parties can be submitted.

Thereafter, another opportunity was sought to get the statements recorded and in terms of the order dated 20.11.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 10.12.2018 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise in terms of the order dated 06.12.2017.

The report has been received to the effect that on 10.12.2018,

the complainant did not come present and the case was adjourned to 23.01.2019. On account of absence of the complainant, the statements could not be recorded in the learned trial Court.

None has joined the proceedings on behalf of the petitioner. Even the statements have not been recorded in the learned trial Court despite two opportunities.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
