The present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the official respondents to provide the passage to the land of the petitioner and further for a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for setting aside the impugned orders dated 09.09.2022, 21.11.2018 and 09.10.2019 (Annexure P-11, P-4 and P-9 respectively).
