Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that qua the dispute regarding property mentioned in the petition, the petitioner moved a representation dated 11.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) to SHO, Police Station, Sector 39, Chandigarh-respondent No. 3. She further submits that another representation was given to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh, on 06.04.2023, copy of which is annexed as Annexure P-4, but till date, no action has been taken on the said representations i.e. Annexure P-1 and Annexure P-4, respectively.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.M. Punchhi, APP, UT, Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3.

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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of disposal of the present petition, it would be sufficient, if directions are issued to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh, to decide the representation dated 06.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law.
5. In the circumstances and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 06.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action, as so warranted, expeditiously under the provisions of the law.
6. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
7. Disposed of.
