1. At the outset, the counsel for the petitioners submits that the trial is not progressing ahead since 2018 and since then the learned trial Court has failed to procure the presence of PW DSP Gurtej Singh Sandhu.
2. The State counsel, who is having advance copy of the petition has apprised the Court that trial is going on and already 6 witnesses have been examined out of total 11 witnesses on behalf of the prosecution and the next date fixed before the trial Court is 3.7.2023.
3. At this stage, the counsel for the petitioners made prayer that he will be satisfied if direction is given to the trial Court to dispose of the case in a time bound manner.

4. In the light of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the trial in an expeditious manner preferably within a period of 6 months from today.
