Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.105 dated 29.5.2020 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 325, 201 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

2. The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner and his companions attacked the opposite party and caused injuries.

3. Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that actually, a free fight took place between two groups with regard to land dispute and there are no specific allegations against the petitioner and further, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police.

4. State counsel on instructions from PSI Gaurav Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and got effected recovery of wooden *danda* and that the petitioner is not required by the police for any

further investigation or custodial interrogation.

5. Admittedly, in the present case, there are no allegations in the FIR that the petitioner caused any specific injury or snatched rifle of Shiv Charan who belongs to the complainant party.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 1.5.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
