The petitioner seeks direction to respondents No.1 to 4 for fair, transparent and just investigation/inquiry into complaint dated 04.06.2022. In the alternative, it is submitted that the complaint be got investigated by the Bureau of Investigation, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondent No.7 is the cousin of the petitioner. He has produced a fake and fictitious Will dated 06.05.2014 allegedly executed by the father of the petitioner. According to the said Will, respondent No.7 is entitled to 2/3rd share, whereas, children of the petitioner are entitled to 1/3rd share. Nothing has been given to the petitioner. Forging of the Will is a criminal offence and thus, appropriate action should be taken against respondents No.5 to 9.

The same is also under challenge in a civil suit.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and because there exists an equally efficacious and speedy remedy under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., I do not deem it appropriate to exercise jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
