The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the official respondents to send the samples of viscera again for re-examination to some other Laboratory except FSL, Rohtak as the said report is stated to be procured in case FIR No.227 dated 02.05.2018 under Sections 365, 302 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

The learned counsel for the State had initially filed a reply dated 11.10.2022 and has filed a second reply in Court today. The same is taken on record. As per Para 5 of the reply, an SIT was constituted to properly investigate the matter. However, the complainant was not satisfied with the constitution of the SIT. Thereafter, on the request of the complainant-party, the matter was transferred from the SIT to CIA Staff-I, Rohtak. The investigation was conducted by the CIA Staff-I and the matter was investigation from every angle. During the investigation, the co-

was arrested on 10.02.2019, co-accused Surender @ Shankar was arrested on 11.03.2019 and co-accused Suresh was arrested on 16.03.2019. The challan against the abovesaid four accused persons was filed before the Illaqa Magistrate, Rohtak on 06.04.2019. However, the petitioner Saveen was found innocent during the course of investigation.

Faced with this situation, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition.

In view of the above, the present petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
