AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 59 days in filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.2,55,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Fifty Five Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the legal representatives No.1 & 2 of the appellant-Krishna Devi in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques for Rs.1,27,500/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Only) each favouring legal representatives No.1 & 2 of the appellant-Krishna Devi, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 09.02.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per

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annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
