1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short the 'Cr.P.C.'), is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to get a fair investigation done in case FIR No.44 dated 27.02.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Section 302, 323, 336, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'the IPC') and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the son of the petitioner no.1, namely-Harpreet Singh has been arrayed as an accused in the FIR and an *i-20* Car is being projected to be owned by him, whereas the said car was parked at some different place at the time of the incident. He submits that various representations have been given, despite which, it is being said that the car is owned by the son of the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr.M.S. Nagra, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 08.04.2023 (Annexure P2) and proceed in accordance with law thereafter.
