The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions against the private respondents who are alleged to have committed fraud with government exchequer.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that the petitioner has no personal grievance against the private respondents against whom action is being sought to be taken and that he is espousing/pursuing the cause for larger public good. This Court is, afraid that in such an eventuality the petition as a personal cause of action in the present form would not be maintainable.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition so as to file an appropriate petition on the same cause of action in accordance with law.

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Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
