The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.382 dated 29.11.2019 registered under section 5 of Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectnl. Adv.) Act and sections 328, 34, 383, 384, 420, 506 IPC at Police Station, Taraori, District Karnal along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternate remedies as may be available in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel informs the court that matter is under investigation. He submits that at one stage cancellation report was recommended, however, same was not filed before the court concerned and hence the case is pending for further investigation.

In view of the above position, present petition is allowed to be withdrawn as prayed for by learned counsel for the petitioners. However, keeping in view the fact that the FIR pertains to the year 2019 and is still

pending investigation, respondent authorities are directed to conclude the investigation expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from today in accordance with law.
