By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

874	01.12.2019	279/336 of the IPC and Sections 13(2) and 13(3) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan, Act, 2015	Gharaunda, District Karnal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 01.05.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioner may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish Singh, has intimated that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no

more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor he is required for further investigation.

4. After considering the respective submissions and considering the fact that in pursuance to the order dated 01.05.2023, the petitioner had already joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation nor he is required for any custodial interrogation, interim bail granted vide order dated 01.05.2023, is hereby confirmed in the present FIR No.874, dated 01.12.2019, under Sections 279/336 of the IPC and Sections 13(2) and 13(3) of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan, Act, 2015 (Annexure P-1), subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, that the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioners; will not tamper with the evidence; will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

5. The petition stands allowed.
