The instant writ petition had been filed for seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 i.e. the Central Adoption Resource Authority to issue 'No Objection Certificate' for the minor child namely Jasleen Kaur whose "date of birth is 12.09.2018."

Learned counsel assisting Mr. Satya Pal Jain, ASGI, appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has handed over today in the Court, a copy of Support Letter dated 22.06.2022, issued by the Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) whereby the Authority has certified that the adoption under the Hindu Adoption and Maintenance Act, 1956, has been completed on the

basis of Adoption Deed and verification done by the District Magistrate, Hoshiarpur dated 16.11.2021 and that in view of above said Adoption Deed, the issuance of Passport to the adopted child may be considered by the Competent Authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
