The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.44 dated 31.01.2023 registered under Sections 170, 171, 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Section 12 of the Passport Act (added later) at Police Station Krishna Gate Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, Haryana..

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.05.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Randhir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 02.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
