It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had been approaching the respondent for transfer of the property i.e. House No. 1038, Sector 27-B, Chandigarh in his favour on the basis of a registered Will executed by his grandfather, namely, Late Sh. Pyara Singh Sarang. Despite clear instructions and having cleared all the objections at the end of the petitioner, no decision on the same has been taken.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the policy guidelines also covers the case of the petitioner in the light of the Notification dated 08.10.2020 (Annexure P-4). She contends that a representation has been submitted to the respondent by the petitioner dated 15.03.2023 (Annexure P-3), which, till date, has not been responded to nor any decision taken

thereon or conveyed.

Counsel for the petitioner, on this basis, submits that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent to consider and decide the said representation, as has been submitted by the petitioner dated 15.03.2023 (Annexure P-3), within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Dr. Payal Mehta, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition with directions to the respondent to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 15.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) within a period of eight weeks from today. Decision, so taken, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential relief be granted to him within a further period of two weeks.
