1. This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside/quashing of the impugned order dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1 whereby the reference of revision petition filed by the petitioner has been dismissed and also for quashing the order dated 06.10.2021 (Anenxure P-3) passed by the petitioner, vide which, the mutation proceedings with respect to estate of Sukhdev Singh has been decided against the present petitioner in view of a Civil Court judgment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the fact that the Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab has observed in para No.5 of the impugned order that any order passed by the

Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in the RSA filed by the petitioner would be incorporated in the revenue record as and when passed and also in view of para 27 of the judgment of the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in case titled as “Jagjit Singh Vs. Divisional Commissioner, Patiala and others”, reported as 2012(13) RCR (Civil) 96, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to raise all points, which have been raised before this Court in the said RSA. It is further prayed that the petitioner be granted liberty to move an appropriate application before the authorities in case the RSA is decided in favour of the present petitioner.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
